Boundaries

- English Program Erin Ridge (North of Costco), Jensen Lakes, Riverside
- LOGOS Program throughout St. Albert
- Currently boundaries open for both programs until we are 70% capacity (630 students)







Schedule

- AM: 8:44 am 11:35 am
- PM: 12:35 pm 3:20 pm
- No kindergarten on early dismissal (1st Wednesday of the month, except September)
- Staggered Entry August 31, September 1 & 5
- First regular day September 6







Full Day Kindergarten

- Full-day students will be in a combined English and LOGOS program in the pm
- Students stay for lunch and eat in a classroom
- Lunch supervision includes supervisors
- Recess 11:40 am 12:00 pm
- Lunch 12:00 pm 12:35 pm
- PM class begins at 12:37 pm







Fees

- Half-day \$250 for the year
- Full-day \$325/month plus \$250 annual fee
- Full-day fees need to be arranged by September 15th (monthly credit card payments or post-dated cheques)
- \$250 fee due by September 30th







Snacks/Lunch

- Half-day students have snack time
- Full-day students have lunch
- Full-day students also have a snack in the afternoon
- We are an allergy aware school no nuts or nut products
- Full-day students are able to order hot lunch
