5. Teacher Report - Kathy Santrock - JMDTV

- Kathy thanked the council for purchasing the license to use Wevideo. Wevideo is used for video editing.
- Kathy shared some JMDTV segments and spoke about some of the segments (Wellness Wednesday, Feel Good Friday, Star Draws, etc.)
- The platform will be used to create the year end video and a video which will be used at the Junior High open house.
- Drama students will be working to create joke segments and commercials which will air on JMDTV

- Carmen Leibel from CTV will be coming to work with grade 5 & 8 students on public speaking.

6. Trustee Report - John Allen

- Trustee Allen provided an update on some of the most recent events:
- Welcome Back BBQ (The 1st one in over 3 years yielded an attendance of about a 1000 people)
- Certification Program for trustees recently attended training
- 1st Board meeting details are posted on the district website, under governance
- Reviewed policies and put some policies out to stakeholders for review: Smoking & Intoxication
- Completed 1st round of school tours (A visit to Demko is scheduled for November)
- Met with Minister of Education regarding school crowding within the division
- Opening a replacement HIgh School next month
- Zone meetings have occurred
- Public school board has had its AGM
- Alberta schools general meeting is next week
- Kelly inquired about a potential 3rd High School in St. Albert. Trustee Allen responded that the city has set aside some land in NW St. Albert for a future school. There currently isn't any commitment from the government to build a new school. Another option could be to build an addition onto Bellerose, which would increase capacity but not satisfy the demand. There are some challenges with doing so... the land size and also not being able to add enough additional capacity.
- Kelly asked about how to advocate about the crowding curriculum funding. Trustee Allen encouraged council members and parents to advocate to the minister's office.

- There was some discussion around adding a Junior High Rep to the school council. The group decided that it would be best to revisit this idea in one year's time.
