- Congratulations to Kathy Santrock: She will be Demko's Second Assistant Principal next year!!
- Yearbook: Marie Jahner is working on all the layouts. We hope to get yearbook sales posted shortly. Cost TBD.
- Field trips: Walks in the community, St. Albert Heritage sites and multiple other community learning opportunities such as Trout Release and Riverwatch. Spring Clean-up began last week and is ongoing. We are also doing some clean up in the

community.

- Fun Days: Create spirit and positivity for Fridays in May/June. Beach Day, PJ Day, Jersey Day. Next is Anything But A Backpack Day!
- JMDs Got Talent Period 4 on Wednesday, June 26. Grades 4-9 will sign up in a Google Classroom and we will create a live show along with videos that will be run on JMDTV for those that cannot perform in person.
- Air Quality Index Guidelines: Guidelines have been developed by the division so Principals can make better decisions about outdoor activities and try to be consistent in our approach. On days where the AQHI rating is 7 or higher, students will remain indoors and windows will be closed to prevent outdoor air pollutants from entering the building. On days where there is an advisory, admin will check the AQHI at the beginning of the day and again before morning recess and lunch.

- Outdoor Garden: Grade 4s are planting inside in preparation for outside. We will be planting vegetables and our Three Sisters Garden in the next few weeks.

- Track meets: The JMD Junior High track day, Division Track Meet took place. elementary 4-6 meet upcoming Great attendance and participation. Concession/food delivery a hit!
- Ben Stelter Day and Cake Walk: May 27th. Fantastic event! We raised just over \$2900.
- Spring Showcase: Mrs. Banu showcased the work her band and music students worked on throughout the year.
